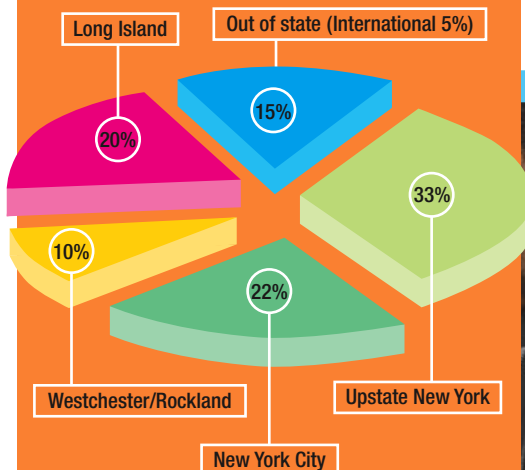

A RESIDENTIAL COMMUNITY

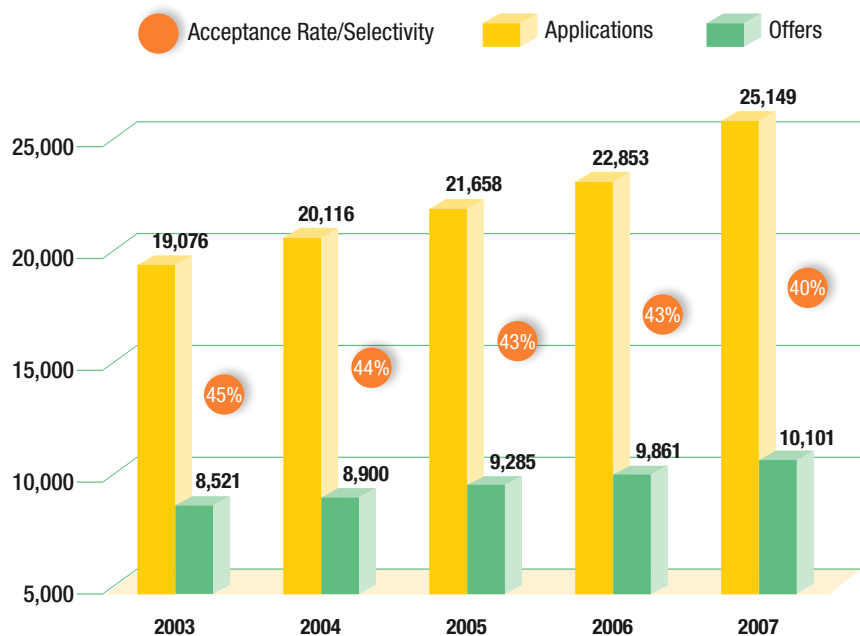
- 90% of freshmen live on campus

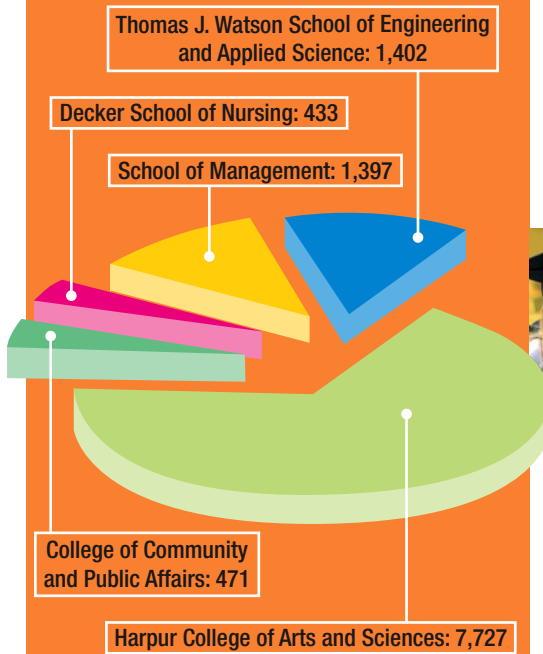

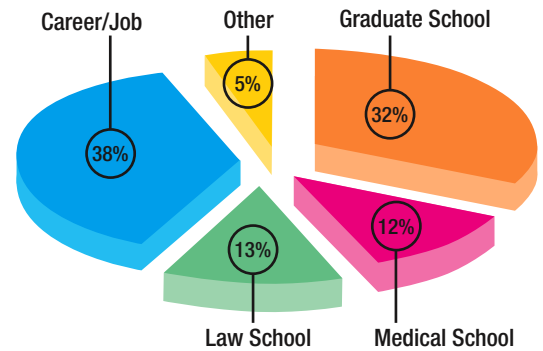
RETENTION RATES

Education Trust

- Graduation rates: 4 year 67%, 6 year 79%
- 25% of undergraduates go on to Binghamton's graduate schools
- 75% of applicants are admitted to the top 50 U.S. law schools
