WELCOME

We welcome your application for internal transfer/dual degree to the Decker School of Nursing, and encourage you to obtain more information and academic advising before you complete the application.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Requests for IUT and DD admission must be received in the Office of Undergraduate Admissions (Academic Building A) by March 15 for fall admission. Decker does not accept applications for spring semester.

Decision letters are sent to the student's current mailing address when school is in session and to the student's permanent address during vacations/breaks.

Students must notify the Office of Undergraduate Admissions in writing if they do not wish to accept the offer of admission.

Late applications will be considered on a space available basis.

Admission decisions are usually made after semester grades are available.

Return your completed application form to the Office of Undergraduate Admissions, Academic Building A.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Admission is selective. A minimum GPA of 3.0 is required for consideration, but does not guarantee admission, due to the competition for space available.

Students should have a strong record in all high school and college courses, especially in the sciences and other prerequisite courses.

PRE-REQUISITE COURSES

- Two College level composition courses
- One course in descriptive statistics
- Human Anatomy and Physiology I
- Human Anatomy and Physiology II
- One introductory biology course
- One course in microbiology
- One introductory psychology course
- One developmental psychology course
- General Chemistry I (inorganic)
- General Chemistry II (organic/biochemical or inorganic II)
