

**CALIFORNIA IGETC EQUIVALENCIES TO
BINGHAMTON UNIVERSITY
OF THE STATE UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK
GENERAL EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS.**

The Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) is a series of courses that prospective transfer students attending California Community Colleges may complete to satisfy the lower-division breadth and general education requirements at both the University of California and the California State University systems.

This chart provides equivalencies between the IGETC and Binghamton University of the State University of New York General Education requirements.

Completion of the Binghamton General Education requirements is not an admission requirement or an admission guarantee. Any requirements not completed prior to admission, may be completed as a student at Binghamton. A grade of "C" or better is required for a course to transfer and at least a minimum of 30 semester credit hours is required to complete the general education requirements.

This chart is intended as a guide to course selection that fulfills Binghamton General Education requirements. Students contemplating a major in accounting, business, computer science, engineering, nursing, physical and natural science or mathematics should balance course selection each semester to include both lower division major pre-requisites and general education requirements. Certain courses may fulfill both a general education and major requirement.

* **ORAL** - must include two oral presentations and evaluation of speaking

** **Foreign Language (FL)** for transfer students is fulfilled by one college course in foreign language at any level or by demonstrating a level of proficiency equivalent to passing the third high school year of a foreign language with a grade of 85 or higher in the course or on the New York State Regents Exam. The foreign language requirement is waived for students in the Watson School engineering majors.

*** **MATH** - must be statistics or calculus – not pre-calculus
