WELCOME

We welcome your application for internal transfer/double degree to the College of Community and Public Affairs, and strongly encourage you to obtain more information and academic advising before you complete the application.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Requests for IUT and DD admission must be received in the Office of Undergraduate Admissions (Academic A) by:

- December 1 for Spring admission
- May 1 for Fall admission

Decision letters are sent to the student's current mailing address when school is in session and to the student's permanent address during vacations/breaks.

Students must notify the Office of Undergraduate Admissions in writing if they do not wish to accept the offer of admission.

The College of Community and Public Affairs is notified of the internal transfer/dual degree decisions and students should contact the CCPA Advising Office prior to the beginning of the semester to plan coursework.

Late applications will be considered on a space available basis.
Admission decisions are made after current semester grades are available.

Return your completed application form to the Office of Undergraduate Admissions, Academic Building A.
