## INTRA-UNIVERSITY TRANSFER (IUT) OR DOUBLE DEGREE (DD)

### WELCOME

We welcome your application for internal transfer or double degree to Harpur College of Arts and Sciences. We encourage you to obtain information and academic advising before you complete the application.

### APPLICATION PROCESS

Applications are available online at <http://apply.binghamton.edu> or in the Office of Undergraduate Admissions, Academic Building A.

### Deadlines

Requests for an IUT or a DD admission to Harpur College must be received by the Office of Undergraduate Admissions by the following dates and deadlines:

Suggested application date:	Application deadline	Semester Admission
• November 15	December 20	Spring Admission
• March 15	May 15	Fall Admission

Late applications will be considered on a space-available basis  
Admission decisions are made after current semester grades are available

Note: Intra-university consideration may be made for transfer applications received at the start or in the midst of a semester if a student has completed two semesters of coursework **and** has a GPA of 3.0 or greater.

### Decisions

Decision letters are sent by the Office of Undergraduate Admissions at the end of each semester. Letters are mailed to students' current mailing addresses when school is in session and to students' permanent addresses during vacations/breaks.

- Admitted students must notify the Admissions Office if they do **not** wish to accept the transfer offer
- Students who are not admitted may apply for admission in a future semester

### ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Harpur College accepts matriculated students with at least a 2.7 cumulative Binghamton grade point average, or who have earned a 3.0 GPA after two semesters of Harpur College coursework and are otherwise in good standing.
- Applications from other students in good academic standing are reviewed on a case-by-case basis.
- If your GPA is less than 2.7, it is imperative that you meet with Harpur College Academic Advising Office prior to submitting your IUT application in order to begin a case-by-case review. When you contact the Harpur Advising Office to schedule a time to meet, please clearly indicate that you plan on submitting an IUT application, but at this time you do not meet the 2.7 GPA requirement.
