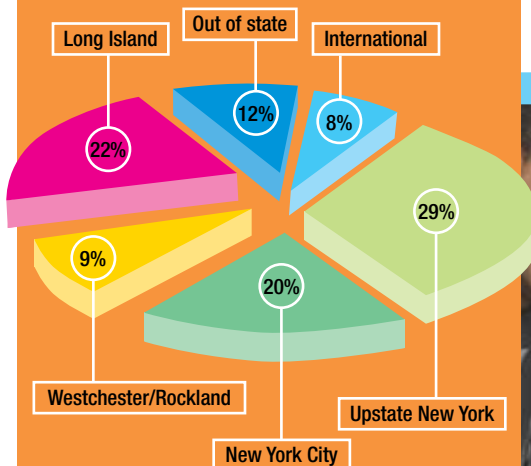

## A RESIDENTIAL COMMUNITY

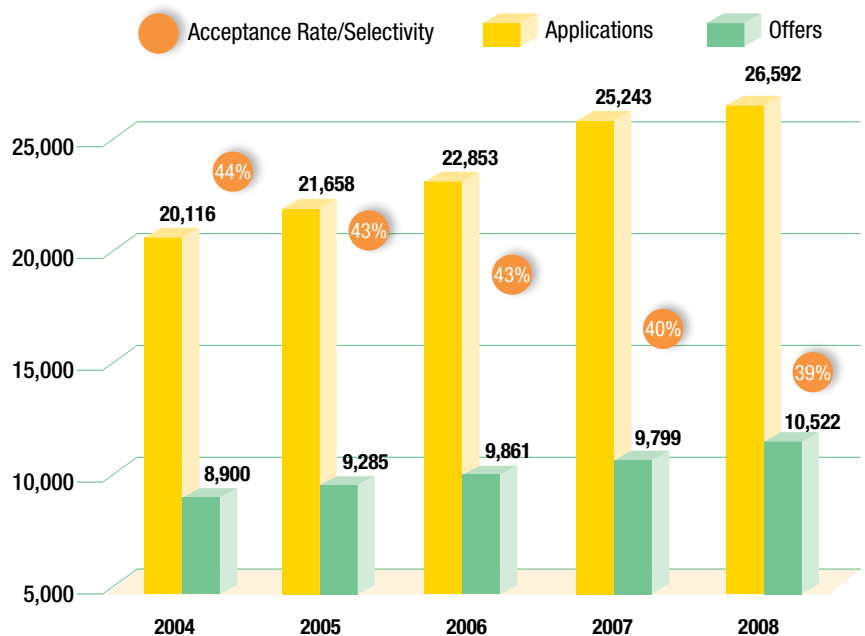
- 98% of freshmen live on campus

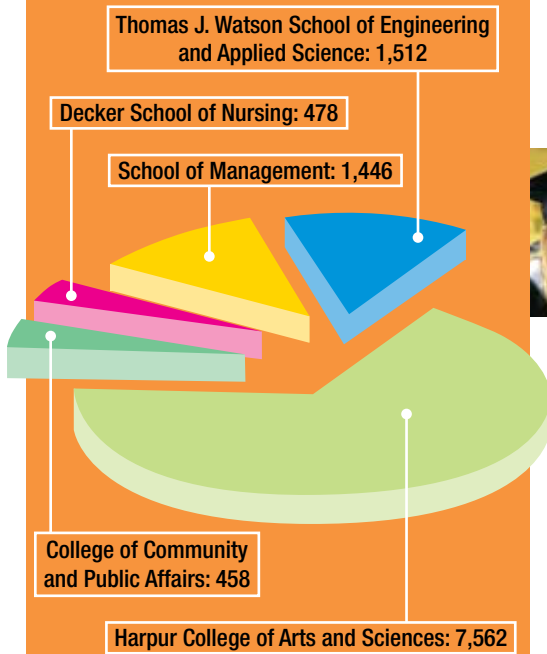

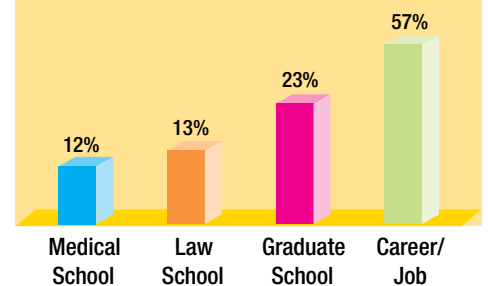
