

## **Talent Review for Art**

Submitting a special talent for review at Binghamton University is simply an opportunity to showcase your talents; **it does not affect your intended major at Binghamton.**

**If you applied Regular Admission, your portfolio must be received by January 15, 2012.**

If your portfolio is not received by the deadline, your application will be reviewed without consideration for the special talent program.

### **Requirements:**

- A letter detailing your interest area(s) in art and summarizing your artistic experience and training. You may send an informal letter and a resume if you wish.
- Please submit a CD with 12 to 15 images of your artwork and a list of the artwork indicating medium and any other relevant information.

Only materials meeting these specific requirements will be reviewed. If you have previously sent a sample of your work, please resubmit your portfolio with the requirements listed above.
