ITINERARY DEPART MAR. 27, 2010 RETURN APR. 5, 2010

- March 27 . . . Depart New York for overnight flight to Athens; amenities aloft.
- March 28 . . . Transfer to hotel. After check-in, orientation to Athens with special focus on Sunday's spectacular Flea Market in the ancient Plaka. (D)
- March 29 . . . Morning devoted to the Acropolis, the Parthenon and the museum. After lunch in a "taverna," explore Parliament House, the Tomb of the Unknown, Constitution Square and the Olympic Stadium. (B/L)
- March 30 . . . The Museum and Study Center of the Greek Theatre is your introduction to this ancient art form. After lunch, examine the magnificent collection of ancient works at the National Archaeological Museum. (B)
- March 31 . . . Our introduction to Greek theater continues with the Megaron and a drive by the Greek National Theater (possibly visit inside). In the evening, attend a show by local performers. (B)
- April 1 Depart for Corinth and its incredible canal. View one of the oldest Greek theaters at Epidaurus. Explore Mycenae, home of the Atreides and the Tomb of Agamemnon. On to Olympia. (B/D)
- April 2 Visit the original "Olympic Stadium" and view the temples built in support of the games. Learn about the ancient customs and traditions associated with the Olympics. Tour the museum with its local artifacts. Drive to Delphi. (B/D)
- April 3 Delphi, home of the most famous "Oracles" in all of antiquity. Explore the site, visit the museum and famous springs, then return to Athens. (B)
- April 4 Visit the Thorikos Theater, the most ancient in Greece and unique for its elliptical shape. Following a typical "Easter lunch," return to Constitution Square or the fun of the Plaka. Balance of day at your leisure. (B/L)
- April 5 Early breakfast followed by a drive to the airport for our return flight home . . . with memories and friendships that will last a lifetime. (B)
