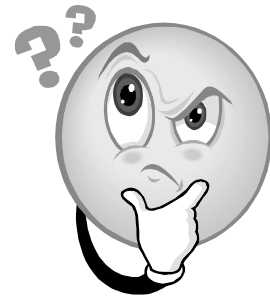


What is a DARS?



Degree Audit Report System

- DARS is a BU Brain program that provides you with a report of your progress toward completing your degree.
- DARS shows you what classes you have taken and how they fulfill degree requirements. It also shows you what classes fulfill degree requirements.
- You can use DARS to track your progress in your declared major and to see what classes you have taken that will also apply to other majors.
- You can also use DARS to see how classes you have taken apply to prospective majors.
- Be sure to communicate with your academic advisor about completing your degree requirements.

How to use your DARS

How to access your DARS:

1. Go to your BU Brain account.
2. Select "Your Records."
3. Select "Submit an Audit."
4. If you are declared, select "Run Audit." If undeclared, select "What if", choose a prospective major, and follow prompts.

How to read your DARS:

- + = fulfilled or in progress to fulfill requirements
- - = not fulfilled yet
- **Ok** = fulfilled or in progress to fulfill
- **No** = not fulfilled yet
- Refer to courses listed in red as possible options
