

## **Economics Undergraduate Awards**

The Department of Economics offers a variety of awards for outstanding academic achievement and service to the department. Each year the department hosts a reception prior to Commencement where these awards are presented.

**Outstanding Academic Achievement Certificate** – this is awarded to all economics majors graduating with a GPA of 3.5 or better in their economics courses.

**Teaching Assistant Certificate** – this is presented to all graduating students who have served the department as teaching assistants during their undergraduate career.

**Foundation Award** – a cash award presented annually to one or two students who have shown exceptional academic achievement in economics.

**Omicron Delta Epsilon** – each year all seniors with a GPA of 3.5 or above in their economics courses are invited by the Department of Economics to join ODE, the national honor society in economics.

**Lovejoy Prize** – endowed by late faculty member Robert Lovejoy and his wife Karen, this award is given on an intermittent basis to a teaching assistant who has shown exceptional commitment to the teaching mission of the Economics Department during the course of their undergraduate career.
