

Adding (“Petitioning”) Economics Courses

There are **NO PETITIONS** for economics courses. Instead the following procedures are in effect:

- **FOR ECON 160 and 162**
 - Students will be able to register on-line if there are open seats available. However, these courses are closed if there are no open seats. Petitions to change discussion sections will not be considered.
- **FOR ECON 360, 362, and 366**
 - Harpur students will be able to register on-line if there are open seats available. **Minors** from other schools might be blocked by the BU Brain and, if so, will need to come to the department to be registered. Students in other schools (not minors) will be informed via their advising office (usually after the first week of classes) if any of these courses are opened for those schools.
- **FOR ELECTIVE ECONOMICS COURSES; ECON 466 and 467**

*NOTE: Students attempting to adjust their schedules at the **START** of the semester **should NOT drop** economics elective courses until they are able to add other economics electives according to the [timetable](#) below. The Economics Department will **NOT** be able to help you.*

Immediately before the semester begins a few (2-3) additional seats will be added to most electives. These seats will be available via the BU-Brain according to the following **Timetable**:

All day Friday – 4:30 PM	ONLY students with 104+ credits can add electives
4:30 PM Friday – 8:30 AM Monday	ONLY students with 88+ credits can add electives
8:30 Monday – 4:30 PM	ONLY students with 56+ credits can add electives
4:30 PM Monday	Class level restrictions will be removed

ECON 466 and 467 will also be restricted to allow only BS students to register until further notice. Any changes will be communicated approximately 24 hours in advance via listserv.

Times above are approximate – each course must be updated individually in the BU Brain.

Students must make sure that they have **COMPLETED** any prerequisites with a grade of C or better before the course begins. **Those who register for a course in which they lack the prerequisite(s) will be dropped from the course.**

NOTE – Students should NOT contact faculty members for permission to add a course. Economics Department faculty and instructors do not have authority to make exceptions to the timetable above.
