## REMEMBER:

- 1) Courses completed with a C-, D or P do not satisfy prerequisite requirements. Students with prerequisite courses in progress during **advance registration** may register, but will be dropped if they do not receive a grade of C or better.
- 2) Courses may not be taken concurrently with the course for which they are a prerequisite (e.g., calculus and ECON 360).
- 3) If the prerequisite courses were **taken elsewhere** please refer to the Transfer Planning Guide for the rules governing grades in such courses, as these rules **also apply to prerequisites:**
