REMEMBER:

- 1) Courses completed with a C-, D or P do not satisfy prerequisite requirements. Students with prerequisite courses in progress during **advance registration** may register, but will be dropped if they do not receive a grade of C or better.
- 2) Courses may not be taken concurrently with the course for which they are a prerequisite (e.g., calculus and ECON 360).

* Or equivalent college level statistics course (CQS 112, MATH 147, MATH 148, MATH 448).

** Or AP 3 or equivalent college level calculus course.

*** These courses MAY be opened to **other schools** at the start of the semester. Check with your advising office.
