

Application and Registration for Scholars IV

DUE the FIRST week of classes in your SENIOR year

Scholars IV calls for students to complete the requirement in one of three ways:

1) Earn honors in the department of the student's major. Check to see if your major has an honors program, and you may then apply if your department or school offers one. You will be required to do a report/special project or take an extra course or seminar in order to earn honors in your major. You must provide the Scholars Office with a Scholars IV application as well as a copy of the final report or documentation that results from this project.

2) Enroll and successfully complete an independent study course/research experience/independent project/capstone project. This requires a scholars IV application form and a copy of the results of the final project: e.g., final report, thesis, description of the project.

3) Enroll and successfully complete a 400-level elective course in your department, but outside of the requirements of your major. This requires a Scholars IV application. Or enroll and successfully complete a 400-level elective course required by your major and identify, with the help of your instructor, an additional requirement which you must meet outside of the course requirements. This requires a Scholars IV application as well as documentation that the requirement has been met.
