Important Notes

1. Try to complete most of the SUNY GenEd requirements during the first 2 years.
2. Grades of C or better are required to transfer courses.
3. The foreign language requirement for all transfers is one college course at any level. Starting Fall 2009 it will be language study through the Intermediate 1 level. Waivers are possible if your native language is not English or if completed sufficient high school language study.
4. * Junior level School of Management courses (numbered 300 or higher) do not transfer from community colleges without passing a validation exam. Exams are given at the start of each semester.
5. ** Managerial Accounting only transfers for students entering the BS in Mgmt program. Acct majors do not take Managerial Acct and so this course would not transfer for them. Business Law 2 would be an appropriate substitution for prospective ACCT majors.
