

MS ACCOUNTING PROGRAM

One-Year Program for Undergraduate Accounting Majors
(from AACSB-accredited institutions/fall admission only)

The basic program of 32 credits is designed for undergraduate accounting majors from AACSB-accredited programs who can complete degree requirements in one year. Coursework taken from a non-AACSB-accredited program is subject to faculty review to determine course waiver eligibility. (*Course waiver guidelines may be viewed at http://som.binghamton.edu/programs/graduate/MSacct_coursewaiver.htm#who.*) Students without an undergraduate degree in business or accounting may be admitted, but will need additional prerequisite coursework (spring admission is permissible for these students).
